#### Ageing population


- 27 million people in the Nordic region
- One in 20 inhabitants is over the age of 80
- The proportion of elderly people in the Nordic region has doubled over the past 100 years
- The life expectancy is increasing



### 20 percent is over the age of 65

Demographic vulnerability indicated by age group 65 and over

- A municipality is considered vulnerable when the proportion of the 65+ age group in the total population is over 19.5 percent
- In about 70 percent of the Nordic municipalities, the proportion of the population in this age group is above the threshold

Phase 3 - Service development


